

How to Make a Paper Plate Dodo Bird Mask

Supplies:

- White paper plate
- Brown foam sheet or scrapbook paper
- Blue paint or marker
- Red permanent marker
- Large craft stick
- Glue or double stick tape

Directions:

1. Cut your paper plate a little more than in half.
2. Draw two round eyes and carefully cut them out.
3. Paint the mask blue and allow to dry.
4. Fold the discarded part of the paper plate in half. Cut out a triangle shape to make the beak.
5. Trace the beak onto a brown foam sheet or scrapbook paper and cut out. Color the tip of it with a red marker.
6. Stick (or glue) onto your paper plate beak.
7. Glue the beak onto the paper plate mask.
8. If you would like to you can glue blue feathers to the top of the mask.
9. Glue the large craft stick to the back of the mask to form a handle for your mask.
